Tournament Rules

- 1. <u>Los Amigos de San Antonio</u> bowling tournament is an invitation non-sanctioned tournament. Only bowlers that are members in good standing with their clubs and USBC are eligible to participate.
- 2. <u>ENTRIES</u> Please submit entries with deposits by April 4, 2025. <u>\$100 deposit with prior registration is required to guarantee your spot</u>. Spots reserved and not paid for by April 4th will be on a first come first serve basis, to those on the waiting list that have paid their deposit. No refunds will be made after the entry has been accepted and scheduled.
- 3. <u>TOURNAMENT FORMAT:</u> Teams will consist of three (3) men and two (2) women or vice versa. Teams will bowl three (3) games on Saturday and (3) games on Sunday. Bowlers may enter only once in this tournament.
- ENTERING AVERAGE: Los Amigos Average of 18+ games, Los Amigos Average of 36+ games, Current highest 2023-2024
 Book Average of 21+ games, or current highest League Average of 21+ games. (No summer league averages accepted).
 ALL OTHERS WILL BOWL SCRATCH 220.
- 5. <u>HANDICAP</u>: Handicap will be based on 80% of 220. There will be <u>NO Maximum on Individual Handicap</u> for bowlers. <u>TEAM CAP is 975 with a TEAM HANDICAP based on 80% of 975.</u>
- 6. All league verification from league secretary must be made available with entry. Verification must be done at least 1 hour before start of the tournament; otherwise, bowler will bowl scratch.
- 7. It shall be <u>EACH BOWLERS RESPONSIBILITY TO VERIFY ACCURACY OF HIS/HER AVERAGE</u>. FAILURE TO <u>USE THE CURRENT AVERAGE SHALL DISQUALIFY THE TEAM IF AVERAGE IS HIGHER THAN ENTERING AVERAGE</u>. THEREBY, RESULTING IN HIGHER HANDICAP. Correction in average will be permitted up to 45 minutes before start of the tournament.
- 8. Tournament management reserves the right to re-rate any bowler prior to or during the tournament (if during the tournament, your team is over the team cap, your team will be disqualified). We also reserve the right to refuse any bowler.
- 9. CHECK IN: 1 hour prior to squad time. Any change in team rosters must be reported 1 hour prior to tournament starting time.

 REARRANGING OF LINE-UP WILL NOT BE PERMITTED. No absentee averages will be used. A bowler not present at start time will receive "0" for each frame missed. A substitute bowler brought in on Sunday will bowl Scratch (220) regardless of circumstances. If a substitute bowler brought in on Sunday has a higher average then a 220, they'll come in with their current highest average of rule 4, keeping their team cap under 975. REMINDER: If a substitute bowler is brought in on Sunday, the TEAM CAP must still remain under 975 with the 220 avg for that substitute.
- 10. **ABSOLUTELY** no bowling allowed on lanes, one hour prior to squad time.
- 11. 10 MINUTES OF PRACTICE.
- 12. In the event of a tie in the team event, the prize money affecting both finishing places will be split equally between both teams.
